Supplied by the contestant:

- ___ Project for display
- ___ One 3-prong, 20' electrical cord and power strip (if needed for display)
- ___ One page, typewritten resume for each team member (submitted prior to contest day)

Supplied by the Technical Committee:

- One 8' wide by 8' deep space supplied with a 6' table (chairs will be available)
- One standard 120-volt electrical outlet

Clothing requirement:

Official SkillsUSA attire as indicated in the "SkillsUSA Championships Clothing Requirements" section of the 2023 SkillsUSA Technical Standards. Occupational attire will not be acceptable.

Pre-Contest Meeting and Contest:

Date: Thursday, March 30, 2023

Set-up: Immediately following Pre-Contest Meeting

Pre-Contest Meeting: 1:30 p.m. (all team members must be present)

Contest time: immediately following Set-up

Location: Civil Technology Center – Room 102

Notes:

1. Contestants will be assigned a presentation time (by Pathway) at the pre-contest meeting.
2. Contestants must take the SkillsUSA Knowledge test prior to the conference. These tests will be taken online and proctored at the contestants' school.
3. Teams will not be allowed in the contest area during the contest time unless presenting.
4. A resume for each team member must be uploaded by the deadline. The only resumes accepted on-site will be for substitutions. These resumes will be collected at the pre-contest meeting.
5. Tear down will immediately follow the last judged entry. Contestants may not disassemble the display and remove any items from the contest area prior to the announcement by the contest chair.
6. Meals will not be delivered to the contest site. Contestants can eat after the close of the contest or may leave the area when not presenting. Plan meal times accordingly.
7. Guidance and supervision by career pathway instructors, counselors, and career and academic teachers is encouraged, but advisors may not assist in the setup or presentation.
8. Medals will be awarded by career pathway. Winners in each pathway (not cluster) will be eligible to compete at the National Leadership and Skills Conference.
