Contest Description:

Teams of two contestants are required to shoot and edit a one-minute video **on-site** that conveys the assigned theme. Editing is done in the contest area with special emphasis on professional production of the video by industry standards, quality of audio and video, and adequate conveyance of the theme to the viewer. **All work for the contest will occur during SkillsUSA State Contest. No work will be created in advance.**

**Memory cards will be formatted at the beginning of the production phase. Please ensure other media is transferred prior to the contest. Contestants are expected to know how to perform a format operation on their camera.*

***Microphones, audio recorder, headphones, headphone y-splitter, & audio cables*

****Resumes are to be uploaded to the Missouri SkillsUSA website prior to the competition. Failure to turn in a resume will result in a point deduction on the team's final score*

Prohibited Equipment:

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Clothing Requirement:

Contestants are required to wear SkillsUSA Class E: Contest Specific-Business Casual Attire during the pre-contest meeting on Thursday and during the contest on Friday. *Contestants may wear the white SkillsUSA polo or the red Missouri SkillsUSA polo.*

Pre-Contest Meeting:

The contest chair expects all teams to attend the pre-contest meeting with **both** team members present. If a competitor will not be in attendance due to a valid reason, it is the responsibility of the student's advisor to contact the contest chair **prior to** the pre-contest meeting. Valid reasons: during the time of the pre-contest meeting a student is competing in a SkillsUSA leadership contest or the student is participating in either a MSHSAA sanctioned or Missouri CTSO event. The contest chair's contact information is listed at the end of this document.

Video Submission:

Teams will be required to export their finished video using the H.264 codec. Please know how to perform this task in your editing software prior to the competition. Submissions will be copied from the team's computer to an external drive provided by the contest chair for evaluation by the judging panel.
